- Invoice number & contractor GST number
- Invoice date
- Participant name & address
- Description of work, number of windows & doors installed
- Certification of each window and door including:
  - Make & model numbers for all windows and doors

## OR

NRCan reference numbers or Certified Products Directory (CPD) number provided by one of the following certifying bodies:

- Canadian Standards Association (CSA);
- Intertek Canada (Intertek);
- Labtest Certification (LC);
- QAI Laboratories (QAI); or
- National Fenestration Ratings Council (NFRC)

- Metric U-Factor rating (W/m<sup>2</sup>-K) of each window and door
- Cost (including labour)
- Proof of payment or payment plan (e.g. PAID stamp)
