
## **CleanBC Better Homes Energy Savings Program Sample Invoice**

## Invoice Requirements - Health & Safety Upgrades

You must have an invoice from your approved health and safety contractor, who may be remediating mould, asbestos or pest infestations, for the health and safety rebate. Your health and safety invoice needs to have all the information identified below to meet the program documentation requirements.



- Contractor's company name & address
- 2. Contractor's contact info
- 3. Invoice # and contractor's GST #
- 4. Invoice date
- 5. Participant's name and address
- 6. Describe the work completed, including location in the home.
- 7. Participant Energy Savings Plan eligibility code (ESP1, ESP2 or ESP3)
- 8. Invoice & Rebate calculation
- 9. Balance due = participant portion
