

Invoice Requirements - Insulation Upgrade

Your insulation invoice needs to have all the information identified below to meet the program documentation requirements.



- Contractor's company name & address
- 2. Contractor's contact info
- 3. Invoice # and contractor's GST #
- 4. Participant's name and address
- 5. Installation date
- 6. Describe the work completed. Specifically, in <u>each</u> area of the house that has been upgraded and/or different had a different insulation treatment indicate the following:
 - a. Location of insulation;
 - b. starting and final R-value;
 - c. total amount added in square feet.
- 7. Participant Energy Savings Plan eligibility code (ESP1 or ESP2)
- 8. Rebate calculation*
- 9. Invoice calculation
- 10. Balance due = Participant portion

*Rebate price per square foot can be found in the rebate eligibility requirements.
